

COSMO Regulatory Affairs based on Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central



Improving Efficiencies And Compliance

Within manufacturing industry worldwide, there is immense pressure to streamline and become more efficient across businesses with clearly demonstrated cost justifications. As an enterprise resource planning (ERP) system, Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central automates and simplifies existing processes. There is a need for an ERP system that would readily generate data in an acceptable format to support all internal investigation and reporting functions. In consequence, organizations require a system to improve approval processes for their departments, so that relevant data can be accessed directly.


Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central has one of the largest installed user bases of any ERP system, serving over 150,000 companies. It is important for these organizations to provide accountability throughout its business processes—approval of business transactions via a pre-defined process forms one part of this. Workflows in Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central enable you to define the approval processes for your organization so that business transactions requiring an approval can be completed with the appropriate authority.

Approval Workflow Management

You can devise simple or complex rules, to suit your organization's requirements, which form part of your overall business flow. The workflow engine has been designed with flexibility and performance as the key cornerstones of its architecture.

One of the prime features of Microsoft is to enable you to define simple or complex approval workflows without resorting to writing programming code. You can define these workflows by deciding what conditions should be met before approvals are required.

An approval workflow automatically routes approval requests, assigns approvers and tracks their progress, and sends reminders and notifications when needed. The activity in a workflow can be monitored at record, and the history of approvals in a workflow run is maintained.




Approval log

You can add configurable workflows and enable these for individual processes. COSMO Regulatory Affairs includes a number of preconfigured workflow templates that you can copy to create workflows. Each workflow that you add is unique and can be individualized as needed.

When enabled, approval workflows react in some scenarios automatically or requires users for approval to continue processing. Automatic runs are activated based on triggering events, like modifying records in production order components.

The workflows are designed to create requests for approval of a new value while keeping the old value in case the request is not approved. The new value will not be implemented until the last request is approved.

Workflows in Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central let you route requests to one or more people for their approval. Based on how the workflow is set up, the appropriate approver is then notified that the record requires their approval.



The route taken from the initial triggering of the workflow can vary depending on the nature of the approval.

- · Approval by specific user
- Approval by multiple user of a group (e.g., 4-eyes-approval)
- Approval by sequential approval chain triggered by user (e.g., request must be approved by the first approver before the request is sent on to the next approver. If the request is not approved by the first approver, the request will never go to the next approver.)


If configured, automatic reminders are sent to approval workflow users who fail to meet deadlines.

When the workflow is complete, the history of that run can be reviewed. The Approval En-tries Log in COSMO Regulatory Affairs contains a record of all approval requests that have been triggered by a policy with an approval workflow action. This log provides details (status, approvers, decisions, comments, timestamp) at all times for a given record that is submitted for approval.


Authentication

Unlike paper, digital business processes are executed immediately and workflow rules make it impossible to skip steps and omit signatures. Workflows in Cosmo Regulatory Affairs are designed to collect signatures.

User authentication plays a crucial role in sign-ing transactions. It is the layer of security that is put in place to associate a signature to the approval person, thereby reducing the risk of repudiation.



COSMO Regulatory Affairs uses its own password-based authentication instead of Windows credentials. An approval user needs to create a unique and robust password to en-sure no one else can sign an approval request with their identity.

When a user enters a new password, the password is validated against the authentication policy. The configurable policy includes:

- password complexity rules that indicate the minimum of each character type that a password must contain
- · minimum password length
- password expiry to enforce users to change their passwords frequently
- minimum iterations before reuse of a password (password change history) dictates when a previous password is available for reuse
- number of invalid attempts that the system can allow before locking the user

Business Challenge of Good Manufacturing Practices

Intense regulatory scrutiny means an informatics solution must satisfy both internal and external auditors, including the flexibility to support widely varying review and approval workflows for static data (e.g., product specs) and dynamic data (e.g., test results, batch disposition). For instance, an ERP system deployed at a pharmaceutical company would have to be validated

and satisfy stringent MHRA, good automated manufacturing practice (GMP), and FDA requirements.

Audit trail reviews are not limited to data which influence the product quality directly. His-tory of approval workflows need to ensure reviews processed approvals and in particular, the authentication of each approver.

Conclusion
